

ALEPH BET GAME

Object of the game:

To review the names of the Hebrew letters and be the first player to reach the "END".

Materials needed for 2-4 players:

- 1 die
- 1 pawn per player
- 1 Aleph Bet Game gameboard

To Play:

Each player places a pawn on "START". Players take turns rolling the die and moving his/her pawn. When a player lands on a space with a Hebrew letter, he/she says the name of that letter. If the player is correct, he/she remains on that space and the next player rolls the die. If the player is not correct, the player returns to the space he/she came from and the next player rolls the die.

Winner:

The first player to reach the "END" is the winner.
(Optional: Continue playing until all players reach the "END".)



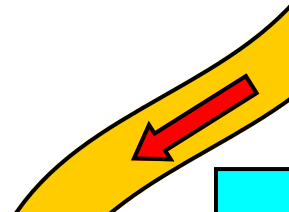
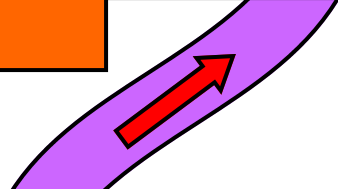
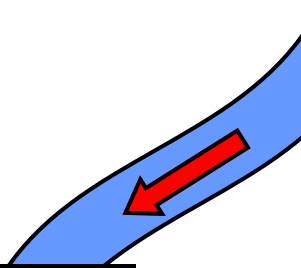
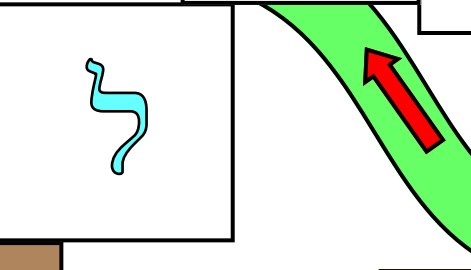
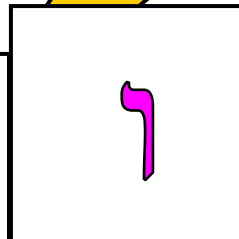
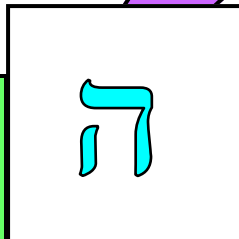
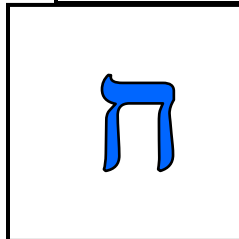
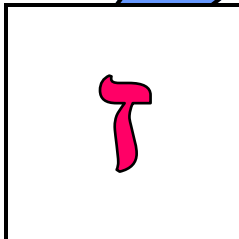
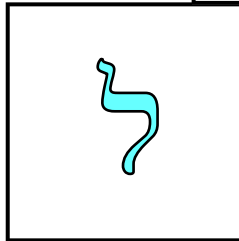
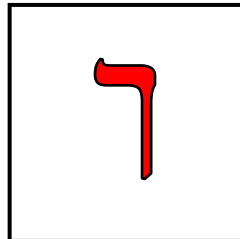
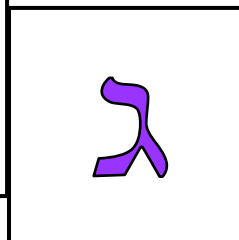
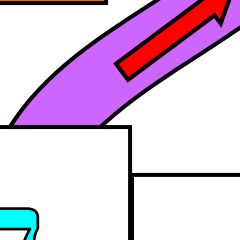
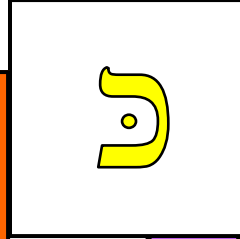
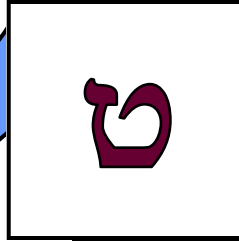
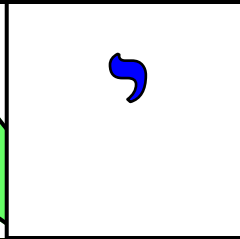
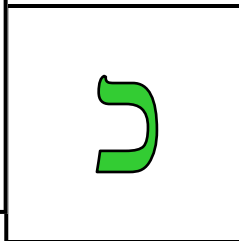
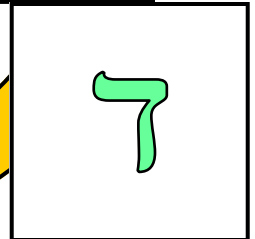
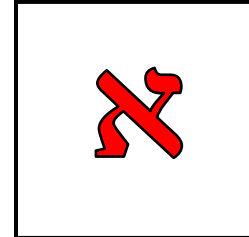
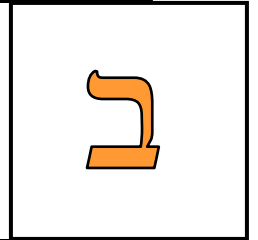
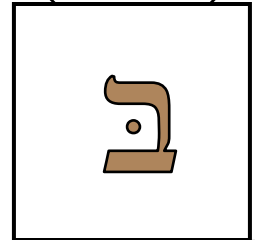
