STEP 2: PAYMENT

Parents – Maximum teen contribution will be \$250 (minus congregational support). Please contact Cindy Becker (cbecker@cajestl.org or call 314.442.3776) to find out if your congregation is participating. (\$250 contribution will be matched by the **Kranzberg Family Foundation** for a total of \$500.)

1. Write out a check for your teens' contribution to the **Jewish Federation of St. Louis** and include your teen's name in the memo line of the check.
2. Mail this completed form along with your check to: **Cindy Becker, CAJE, 12 Millstone Campus Drive, St. Louis, MO 63146.**
3. Get started on a lifetime of "Giving Jewish!!"

Your teen will choose a Jewish non-profit organization to donate 5% of the account balance. For an individual account to remain current, the teen must make his/her annual allocation *and* make an annual principal contribution of at least \$18 to his/her B'nai Tzedek account. Failure to remain current for **two consecutive** years will result in the forfeiture of your account to the B'nai Tzedek Youth Leadership Fund to continue to fund future programming and charitable disbursements to the community.

When the teen reaches the age of 25, if the account has less than \$2,500, the funds revert to the B'nai Tzedek Youth Leadership Fund. If the account *exceeds* \$2,500, the teen participating may continue to manage the fund, making annual distributions of no more than 5% per year. If the fund amount reaches \$10,000 or more, it becomes a donor-advised fund within the Jewish Community Foundation.
