

Chanukah Paper Decorations

1. Flat (1 dimensional) Decorations....(Easy)

Trace large pattern pieces on construction paper and cut out.

A. **Tissue Paper:** Place a large pattern on the newspaper. Paint one side of pattern lightly with liquid starch. Overlap small squares of colored tissue paper on the pattern. Let it dry over night . Turn decoration over the next day and trim away excess tissue paper around the pattern.



B. **Construction Paper Collage:** Cut or tear small pieces of construction paper into small pieces and glue pieces to the dreidle. Punch hole at the top of the dreidle and tie yarn or use large paper clip to hang the decoration.



C. **Gift Wrap Paper Decoration:** Purchase Chanukah paper with multiple Chanukah symbols. Cut out symbols and have students glue one in the center of each pattern on the front and the back.

D. **Misc. Collage Decoration:** Glue small pieces of yarn, ribbon, sequins, packing styrofoam pieces, colored macaroni, etc. to one side of decoration.

E. **Picture Decoration:** Glue a picture of the child on one side and decorate the other side.

2. "3 D" Decorations

A. Cut out and fold 2 dreidle patterns in half. Place pattern pieces together and staple two times along the center fold line to form "3D" decoration.



B. The shapes must be the same but each piece may be a different color.

C. Glue a small Chanukah symbol or design in the center on each of the four sides.

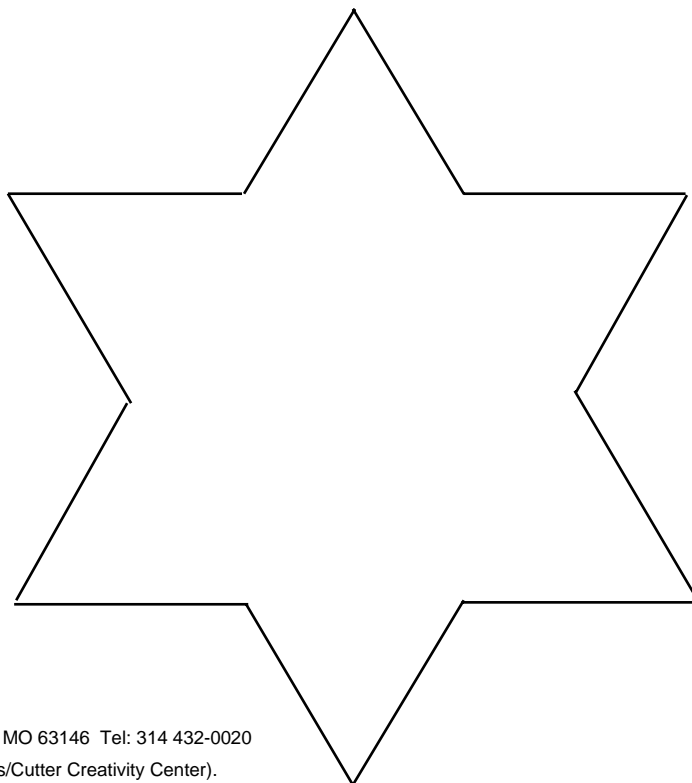
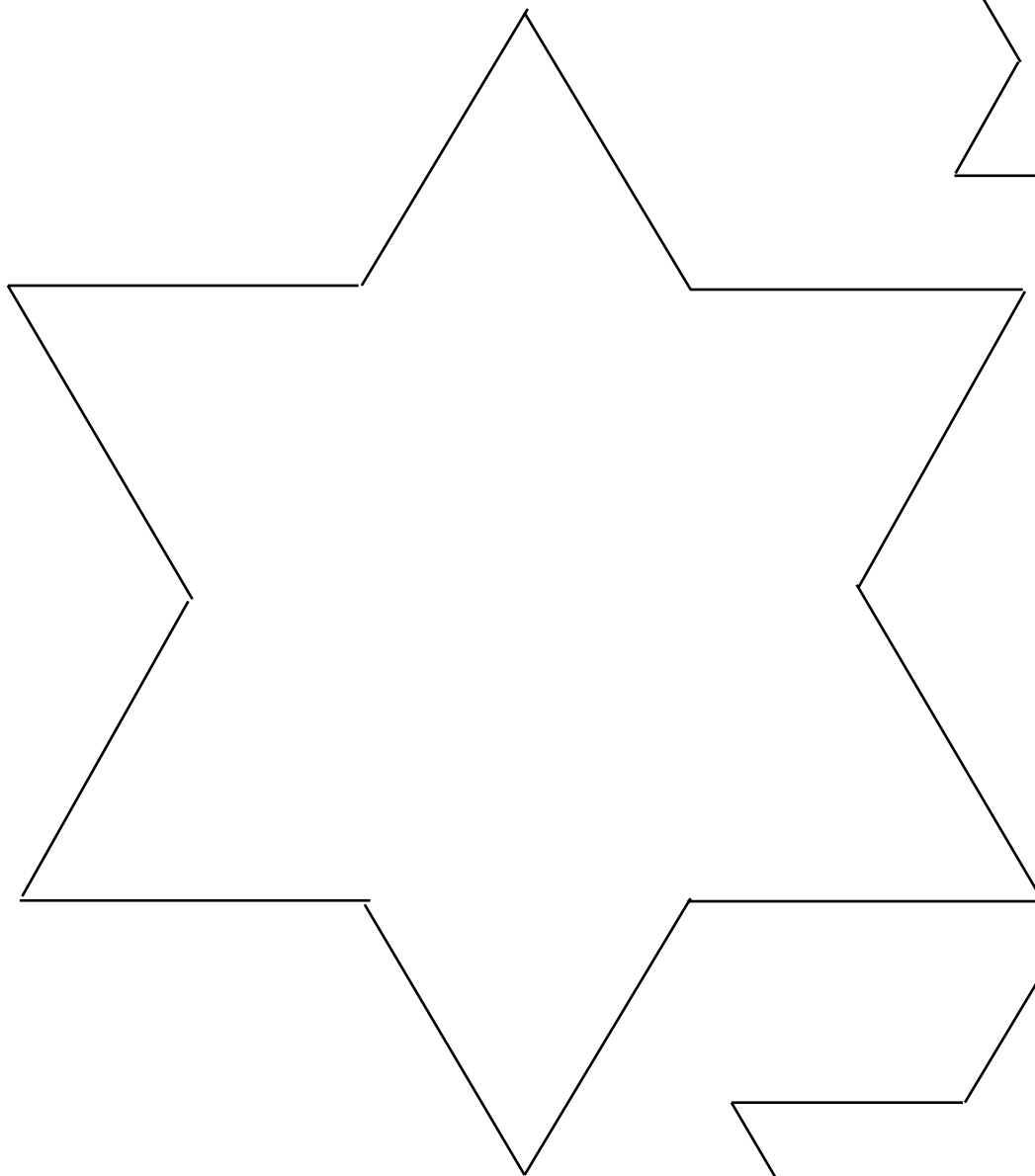
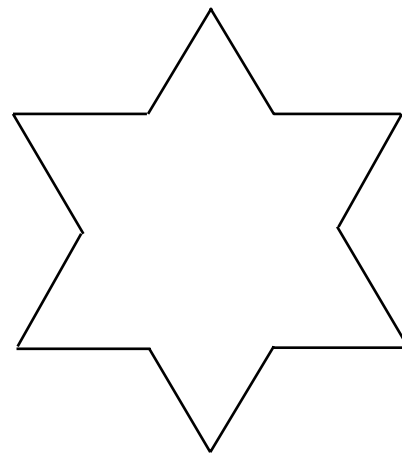

Hanging Chanukah Decorations: Punch a hole at the top of the decoration. Tie a piece of yarn or use a large paper clip to hang the decoration. Bend the paper clip open and attach one end to the decoration. Make a paper chain to hang decorations. Cut 9"x 12" multicolor construction paper into 1 1/2 " x 9" strips. Use glue sticks to assemble the chain.



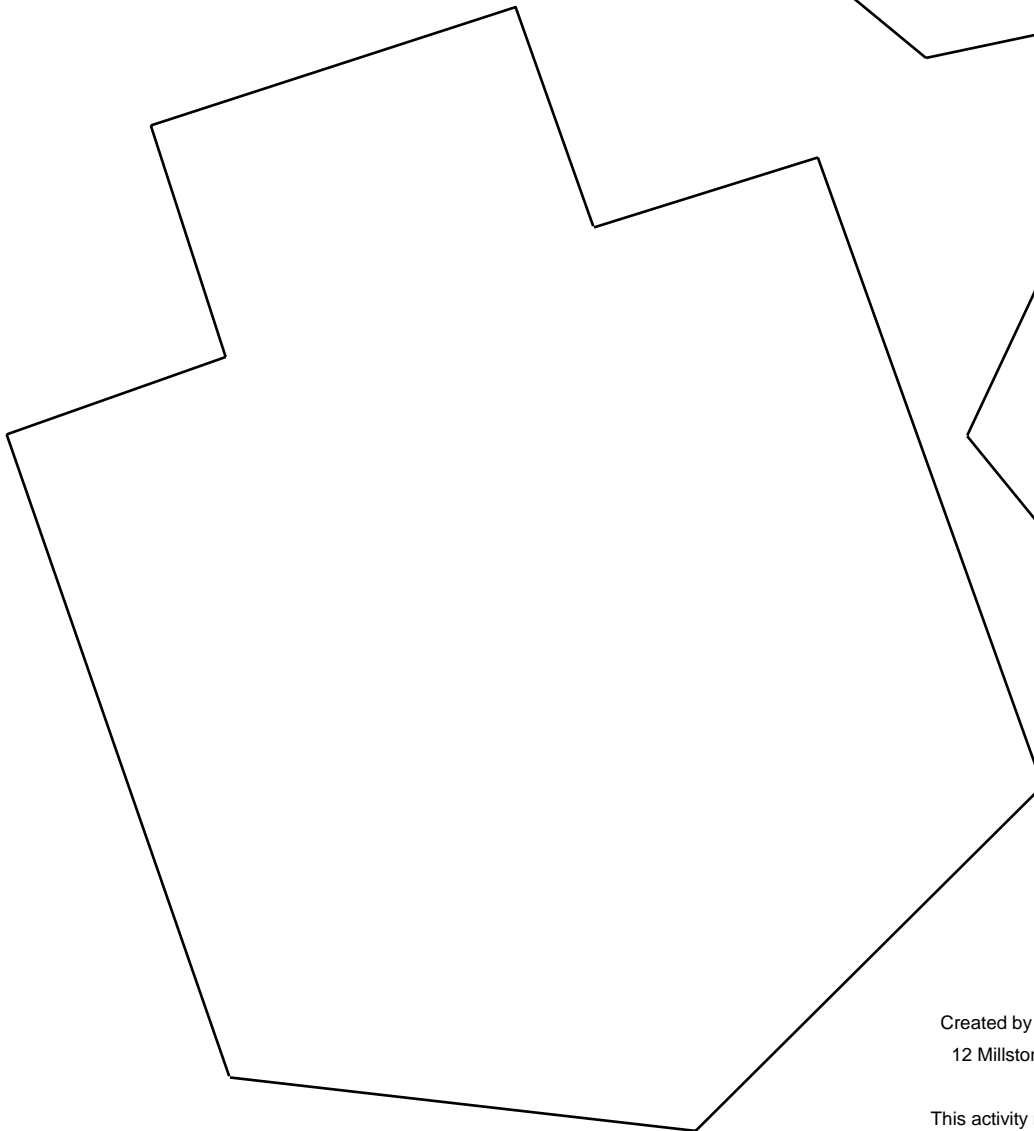
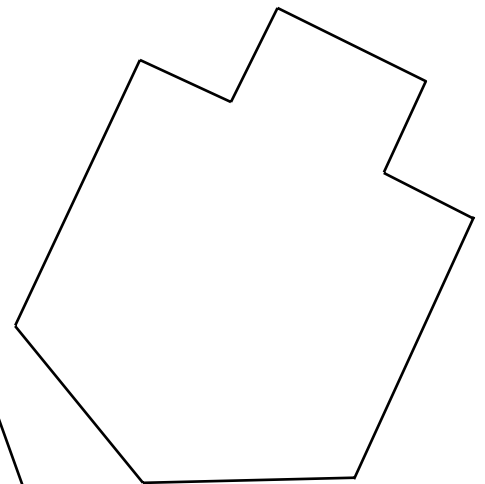
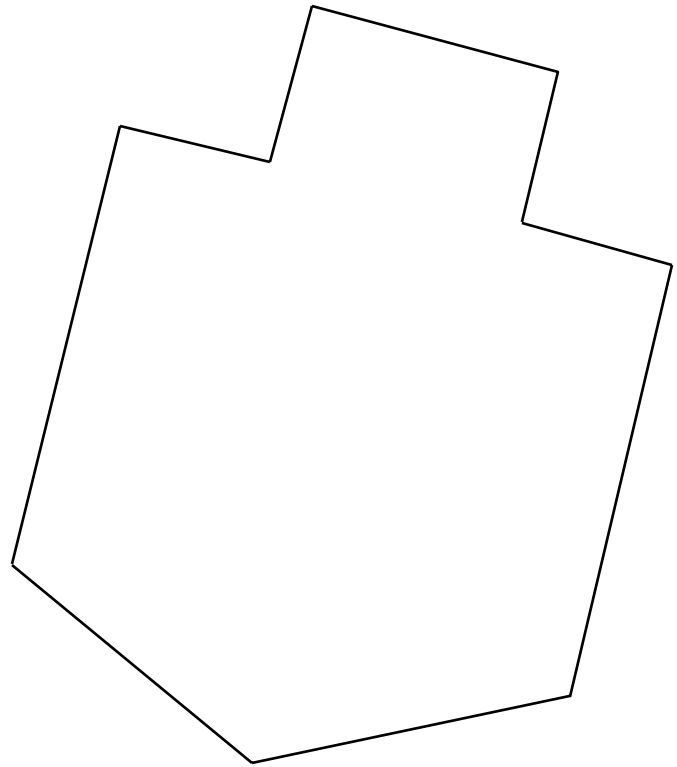
Star of David



Make star patterns. Trace each size pattern on a different color of construction paper. Glue the small star on the middle size star. Glue the middle size star on the big star. Punch a hole at the top to hang the star.

Dreidle

Make dreidle patterns. Trace each size pattern on a different color of construction paper. Glue the small dreidle on the middle size dreidle. Glue the middle size dreidle on the big dreidle. Punch a hole at the top to hang dreidle.
