



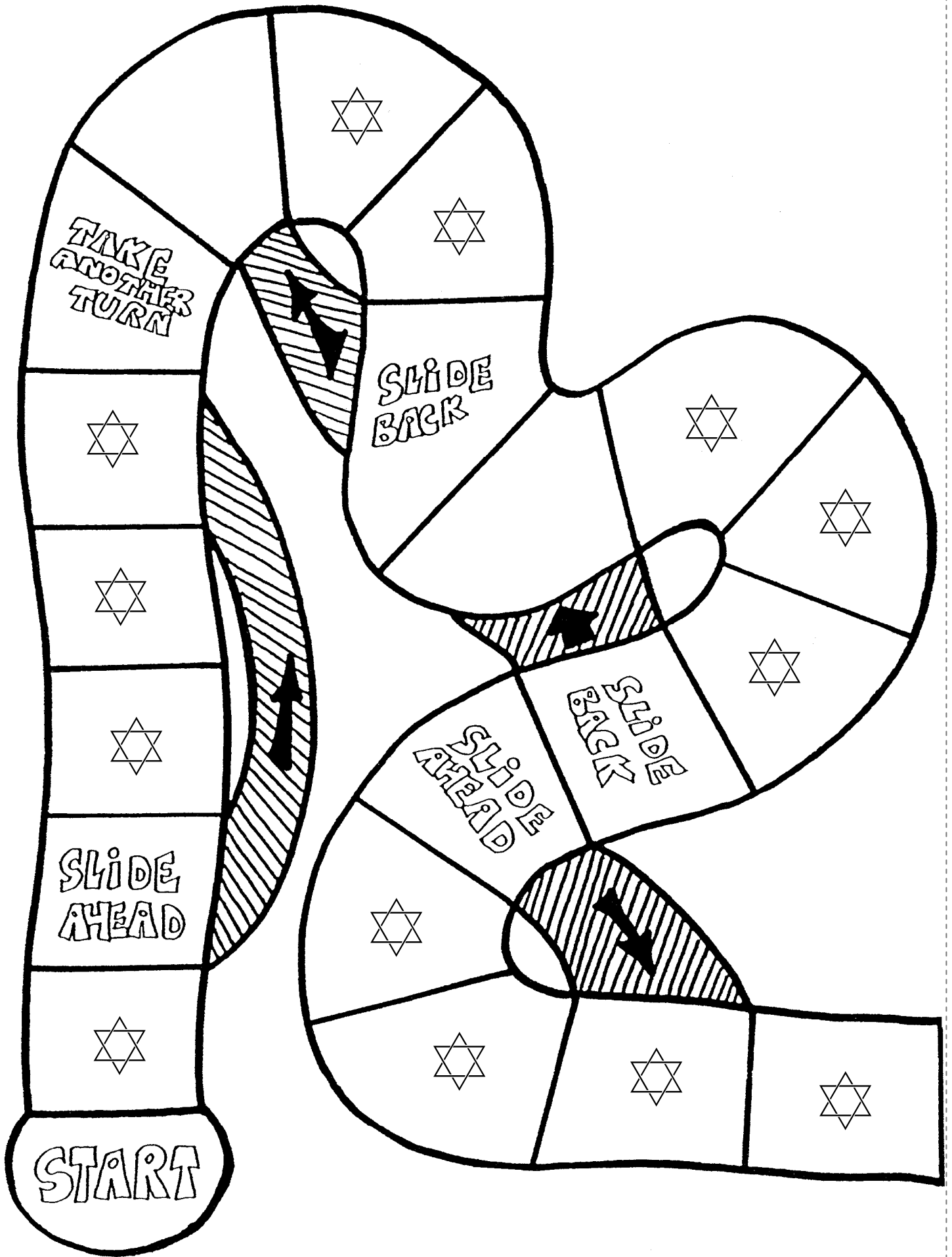
Playing Directions When Using Question Cards: Place pawns on “START”. Put *Question Cards* in one pile with the questions facing up. Players take turns rolling the die and moving around the game board. If a player lands on a star, the player takes the top card from the *Question Card* pile and gives the answer. Then check the back of the card. If the answer is correct, the player stays on the space where he/she landed. If the answer is wrong, the player goes back to the space the player just came from. The first player to reach the “END” is the winner. A player does not have to roll the exact number to win the game. More than one player may occupy the same square.

Playing Directions When Using Hebrew Alefbet or Prayer cards: Use Hebrew alefbet or prayer cards for *Question Cards*. When the player lands on a star, the player identifies the Hebrew letter or reads a prayer phrase.
