Judaism's Wildest Fairy Tale?"**

Among the books of the Apocrypha, the Book of Tobit contains all of the excitement of a romantic fairy tale; including the angel Raphael, the demon Asmodeus and a large dangerous fish. The story, found in 5 copies among the Dead Sea Scrolls, combines Jewish piety and morality with oriental folklore. Come discover why this book is so important to the study and development of Judaism. Fiction or Fantasy? Tobit might just be Judaism's wildest fairy tale. Course taught by Dr. Naomi Jacobs, internationally recognized expert on the Book of Tobit, about which she has a forthcoming book. Dr. Jacobs is an accomplished educator and has recently been on the faculty of Washington University.
